### About Winemaker Bibiana

Bibiana González Rave crafts her Alma de Cattleya wines as high-quality offerings representing the uniqueness of Northern California: Sonoma and Napa County. Alma means “soul” in Spanish—and Cattleya is the national flower of her native country, Colombia. These wines are the perfect accompaniment to everyday meals and relaxing moments.

**Source:** Every year, the fruit for this Rosé is sourced from some of the coolest areas in Sonoma County, mainly the Russian River Valley and Carneros AVAs. This wine is comprised of a selection of clones 115 and Pommard.

**Harvest:** Fruit was hand-picked at night and delivered to the winery at very low temperatures to keep the grapes cold.

**Winemaking Process:** The grapes are placed directly into the press after hand-sorting. Our small winery operation allows us to give great attention to detail in all aspects of the winemaking process. The end result is a bright, crisp Rosé of Pinot Noir, with intense and complex aromatics.

**Aging:** This wine was aged in neutral French oak barrels for four months before bottling.

**Bottling:** January 18th, 2022. 1000 cases made.

We use the innovative DIAM corks to ensure there is no cork taint in any bottle. If you find a corked bottle, I am happy to replace it with a full case.

## Tasting Notes

Sporting a delicate peach and pale pink color, this rosé of Pinot Noir offers incredibly pure aromas of macerated strawberry, rose water, and orange zest. Vibrant flavors of fresh red berries and nectarine combine with youthful acidity to dazzle the palate.
