<b>WINE TYPE</b>	Rose
<b>VARIETALS</b>	Mourvedre (Monastrell)
<b>VARIETAL NOTES</b>	55% Mourvedre, 45% Grenache
<b>VINEYARD</b>	The Mataro is sourced from the sandy soils and own-rooted vines of Oakley along with a dash of 1920s-planted fruit from the famed Pagani Ranch. The deliciously feral and wild Mataro element is enlivened by Grenache planted in the 1880s at Gibson Ranch in Mendocino's McDowell Valley.
<b>VITICULTURE</b>	Farmed using organic methods
<b>VINIFICATION</b>	The grapes were harvested specifically for rose at relatively low sugars to maintain freshness.
<b>AGING</b>	Stainless steel tank
<b>NOTES</b>	From a color perspective, this is the palest rendition of this wine we have made in a while, something that belies its richness and density. Composed of 55% old vine Mataro and 45% old vine Grenache, Ode to Lulu is Bedrock's love letter to the Bandol rosé they love so much.



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
