

DOMAINE OLLIER-TAILLEFER

CLOS DES MURETTES ROUGE



GROWING REGION:

Faugères, Languedoc, France. Faugères is one of the smallest, most compact of Languedoc's appellations, and one of the highest.

TERROIR:

Based on uniquely schist soil. The first ridge of the Cevennes Mountains inland from Béziers and the coastal plain. Altitude 250-300 meters, and most of Ollier-Taillefer's parcels are on the rolling hills at the top of the ridgeline in the 300-meter range.

GRAPES:

50% Grenache,
30% Syrah
20% Carignan

VITICULTURE NOTES:

Hand-picked and de-stemmed. Aged in tank. Certified organic. Production averages 5,500 cases.

TASTING NOTES:

The schist geology for red wines translates into decidedly dark fruit profiles and inky, long, and very mineral--think slate--wines. Deliciously Languedocien.
